Instructors also have the opportunity to work in schools, periodically providing Dryland Skating School Sessions. All shifts are posted and commit to using When I Work.

- Loves working with children and youth of all ages to instruct classes K-12
- Is positive, collaborative, and has an abundance of energy
- Has had experience working with children at summer camps/community centres/sports instructor/coach

- Is confident working independently
- Is punctual and possesses excellent time management skills
- Is ambitious about learning and training to become one of the best instructors in the world
